Behaviour Flow Chart



Minor Incident
Low-level behaviour in the classroom or on the yard



Initial Verbal Reminder
Pupil will be reminded of our G2BG and Rights Respecting rules



Second Verbal Reminder
Pupil will once again be reminded of our G2BG and Rights Respecting rules



Warning Card
Pupil will receive a yellow warning card and miss 5 minutes of playtime

Pupil will have the opportunity to revert to green if the behaviour improves



Repeated Yellow Behaviour



Consequence Card
Pupil will receive a red consequence card leading to 15 minutes of reflection time during the lunch hour with a member of the SLT (Senior Leadership Team)

Pupil will lose 5 minutes of 'Golden Time' at the end of the week.

Pupil's parents will be informed via text when a red card has been issued
