Internally, the school uses the information to target, track and monitor pupil progress and put interventions in place where necessary (including the planning and targeting of support and resources for pupils with different needs). It is also used to inform teaching and learning. Externally, information is sent to RCT within statutory returns.

Reports are produced and distributed to parents.
