### The Home Agreement/ Parent's Responsibilities

### Photographs/Video & Internet Use



As part of the children's curriculum, and development of computer skills Parc Lewis Primary School is providing all children with supervised access to the Internet and email.

Rhondda Cynon Taf Council has an effective filtering system in place to ensure that unsuitable material cannot be accessed by the children.

- ❖ I am willing for my child's photograph or video to be used in any school publicity, documents or displays e.g. the school website, twitter, prospectus, google classroom, notice boards and publications by local newspapers.
- ❖ I am willing for my child to use the internet with supervision.
- ❖ I agree that any photographs/videos I take during school events are not uploaded onto social media, unless they are photographs/videos of only my child/children and no other children/parents or staff are in the background.

## Hwb – Additional Services for Learners.

Hwb is an online platform which gives teachers and learners access to a wide range of digital tools and resources. National Reading and Numeracy Tests are now set via personalised assessments which school send securely as statutorily required to the Welsh Government. By giving consent to school we will enable your child to have access to all the Hwb Additional Services. The Welsh Government and school will securely share information about your child with service providers including Microsoft and Google for Education, in order to create a secure account to enable them to access the additional services.

## Routine Visits

- ❖ I give permission for my child to participate in routine visits off the school premises site during school hours such as:  
Walking to Taff Vale Park, Ynysangharad Park, Pontypridd Muni, Library, Museum,  
Local Playgrounds, Roads and Shops.
- ❖ I understand that all reasonable care will be taken for my child during these visits, and that my child must obey directions given and to observe all rules & regulations governing these visits – children will be subject to all normal school/establishment discipline procedures during the visit.
- ❖ I will inform the school/establishment of any medical or behavioural condition or physical disability that may affect them during the visit.

All young people are covered by R.C.T's third party public liability insurance in respect of any claim arising from an accident caused by a defect in the school/establishment premises or equipment or attributable to negligence by the Council or one of its employees. Please note that the insurance does not include personal accident or personal belongings cover for your child.

## INFORMATION FOR PARENTS - Hwb & Twitter



The Hwb platform provides all maintained schools in Wales with access to a wide range of centrally-funded, bilingual digital tools and resources to support the digital transformation of classroom practices. The Hwb platform is managed and operated by the Welsh Government. All pupils in maintained schools in Wales must be provided with a secure log-in to the Hwb platform. This is because mandatory reading and numeracy tests, currently on paper, will be moving online and must be completed by each pupil via the platform. In order to provide [you / your child] with a secure log-in, the school will be sending basic information to the Welsh Government. The log-in will allow [you/your child] to take the mandatory online assessments, known as 'personalised assessments'. 2 Additional services If you agree, Welsh Government can also provide [you/your child] with access, via the Hwb platform, to a variety of additional services which are provided by other organisations. These additional services are centrally funded and there is no cost for you or for your school to access and use them.
