### School times

Reception children should arrive at school between **8.45-8.55am**. Children should be collected at **3.15pm**.



### Read Write Inc

Please support your child by practising Read Write Inc sounds and words that are sent home.



### Reading books

Oxford Reading Tree books should be brought in to school with your child's reading record **on their reading day**. Please try to read with your child as often as you can.



### Snack

Snack money for this half term is **£7**. If you would like your child to take part in school snack then money must be brought in to school in an envelope with your child's name on by **Monday 10th January**. If your child brings their own snack in to school then please remember that this must be **fruit, vegetables or breadsticks only**.



Please send a water bottle with your child's name on in to school with your child. **This must contain water, not squash or juice**. We will send water bottles home every day to be washed and refilled.

### Clothing

Please make sure that all items worn or brought to school have your child's name on them. Please send your child to school in sensible coat and shoes - Velcro shoes are easiest for children at this age.



### PE

PE sessions for Reception will be **every Friday**. On Fridays, children should come in to school dressed in their PE kit - t-shirt, joggers/leggings and trainers (no laces please). **Please remove your child's earrings on Fridays**.



### Supporting your child

Please encourage your child to be independent by dressing and undressing themselves and teaching them how to put their own coat on and do their zip up. Please support your child's development at home by reading stories with them, singing songs and playing games.
