groups they will learn new sounds and how to blend and segment words. Please support your child at home by practising sounds and completing RWI homework

Reading books



Reception children will take home Oxford Reading Tree books which should be

brought in to school with your child's reading record on their reading day. Please try to read with your child as often as you can.

<u>Clothing</u>

Please make sure that all items worn or brought to school have you child's name on them. Please send your child to school in sensible coat and shoes. Velcro shoes are easiest for children at this age.

<u>Snack</u>

If your child brings their own snack in to school then please remember



that this must be <u>fruit, vegetables or bread-</u> sticks only.

Please send a water bottle with your child's name on in to school with your child. <u>This must contain</u> <u>water, not squash or juice</u>. We will send water bottles home every day to be washed and refilled.

PE

PE sessions for Reception will be <u>every Fri-</u> <u>day</u>. On Fridays, children should come in to school dressed in their PE kit - t-shirt, joggers/leggings and trainers (no laces please).



<u>Please remove your child's earrings on Fridays.</u>
